IMPORTANT DATES:

Rehearsals: Thursdays, 3:30pm-5pm starting 18 FEB through 25 MAR (potentially)
Outside in field/sidewalks/staff parking lot nearest band room outside doors
Our plan is to do the first three Thursday rehearsals (~~18 FEB~~, 25 FEB, 4 MAR) and then
reevaluate whether we need to continue with the extra rehearsals or not

UNIFORM:

Student musicians need to dress WARMLY. I recommend long pants, long sleeve shirts, jackets, coats, gloves (clarinets need to be able to use uncovered finger tips to play), hats, scarves, ear warmers, hot-hands packets, hot-feet packets, thermals, compression stockings, ANYTHING to stay warm. It will not be as much fun if you are freezing cold. We also want you to stay as healthy as possible. Lowering your immune system due to not staying warm and exhausting your body is NOT the goal.
Guard and Percussion: Wear your personal mask at all times.
Woodwinds and Brass: Wear your school provided instrument mask at all times.

EQUIPMENT:

Student musicians need to bring their instrument and sheet music (kept in sheet protectors in a 3 ring binder) to all rehearsals and performances. At the school we will have music stands and clothes pins.

Also ALWAYS bring your mask to wear!

MONEY:

You will not need money for the game. There will not be concessions nor ticket costs for students musicians.

SCHEDULE:

Rehearsals

3:00pm.....Arrive RHS Staff Lot (picture below) - form a carpool line in the staff parking lot, a staff member will come to do temperature checks and health screening
After health screening you may park in any empty parking space or drop off.

Setup – grab a music stand and clothes pins to hold music, leave cases on sidewalk, maintain 8ft distance

3:30pm.....Start rehearsal

4:50pm.....End rehearsal – put away instruments, wipe down music stands and return stands and clothes pins to storage

5:00pm.....Pickup Time

Game Night

5:00pm.....Arrive RHS Staff Lot - form a carpool line in the staff parking lot, a staff member will come to do temperature checks and health screening

After health screening you may park in any empty parking space or drop off.

Leave cases in car.

Setup – grab a music stand and clothes pins to hold music, maintain 8ft distance

*5:30pm.....Start rehearsal

*6:15pm.....Walk to Stadium

*6:25pm.....Star Spangled Banner / Go Northwestern Go

~9:30-10:00pm.....Pickup Time (after end of game, game length of time is variable)

*Senior Night activities are being planned for 26 February game. These times might shift to accommodate.

TICKETS/SPECTATORS: At the moment, I do not have any information regarding WHO can purchase tickets.

I know that, at the moment, we are limited to 100 spectator tickets for the entire school per game night. I think there is still discussion about how to be fair about how to split the tickets between athletes, cheerleaders, and band. I will let you all know ASAP, but I hope to offer our senior parents the opportunity to purchase a ticket first. All tickets will have to be purchased online and names will have to be put on an admit list. The moment that I know more details I will let you know!

NOTE:

I hope that this will be a fun experience for everyone who wants to participate. I also want you to know that it is an optional experience. If you do opt to be involved you need to be involved with all rehearsals and with all of performance nights. This is not a pick-and-choose which part of the experience you want to be involved in.
