#### I. Summer Rehearsals

# III. Fair Share

I want to re-communicate what "Fair Share" is. The band boosters meetings (that everyone is encouraged and pleaded with to attend) are where we have proposed and voted on budget for the year. You can find that budget on the band webpage (<a href="http://www.rolesvillehsband.com/">http://www.rolesvillehsband.com/</a>) click on Band Boosters tab. You'll see at the bottom that the budget divided by the number of students in the program gave us our estimated "fair share of the budget per student". At our last boosters meeting there was a vote to find a way to keep fair share from going over \$600 per student. The first installment was due during band camp for \$150 and our hope is that with the Motors and Market Fundraiser we can lower the overall fairshare for all students (but we need your help there too!). If you wanted to pay by check, please make your checks payable to "Rolesville Band Boosters" and have students put it in a sealed envelope with their full name, how much, and what is it for on the envelope (ex: Jacob J. Smith, \$150, Fair Share). If you would like to pay by card, Ms. April Pearce (our boosters treasurer) can process that.
